**1. Meals:** It was agreed that free meals will be provided for 50 kids and 4 teachers (total cost £218), Pensioners (~30 ) will be asked to pay £2 each (a free drink will be included), giving a total catering cost of £75 for pensioners.

5. Drinks for pensioners	£30
